

# Boxes

## Introduction:


"Boxes" is a simple strategy game for two players. Even kids can play! Simply print out the game sheet, which includes two grids. (You only use one grid per game.) The only other thing you need is a pencil!

## Instructions:

Decide who goes first. Players take turns drawing a single horizontal or vertical line connecting two adjacent dots on the grid. Whenever a player draws the fourth line that turns four dots into a square, he writes his initials in the square and takes a bonus turn. (A player can draw many lines on one turn, provided they keep completing squares.)

When there are no more dots to be joined, players count up the boxes they've initialled. The player with the higher score wins!
